

A 'climate change' agreement was reached in Sharm el-Sheikh on Sunday at Cop 27 - and for the first time, a plan was put in place for providing poorer nations with financial assistance.

These funds are to help rescue and rebuild vulnerable areas that have been hit by climate change. Developing nations have been requesting this help for over 30 years - so this is significant.

However, paying into this fund is voluntary.

A target for peak global emissions in 2025 was also proposed, in line with limiting temperature rises of 1.5 degrees.

Ultimately, we still have a long way to go, but we can still do our bit, no matter where we live.
