Entry requirements

- Minimum age 18 at the start of the training course
- Eligibility to work in the UK
- Resident of Derbyshire at the time of application (There are two exceptions to this; armed forces personnel currently serving or have served in the past; and current Derbyshire Fire & Rescue Service employees with a permanent contract who live outside the Derbyshire border)
- Have a full UK manual car driving licence
- Be confident in and around water and can swim unaided
- No known phobia of heights or confined spaces
- GCSE or equivalent (grade C or 4 and above) in Maths and English. Proof will be required of your qualifications
- Meet required fitness standards and medical health checks including eyesight examinations
- Complete a satisfactory enhanced criminal record check
