### Have your say on anti-social behaviour



Residents are being urged to have their say on plans by North East Derbyshire District Council to introduce new powers to crack-down on anti-social behaviour.

We are asking people for their views on plans to introduce a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) in Clay Cross and adjoining areas.

If approved, the Clay Cross order will come into effect by the end of May and will prohibit any person from participating in a range of anti-social behaviour in the restricted area.
