The aims of this project are:

- Reduce incidents of ASB in the Derbyshire Dales area.
- Increase knowledge of road, water and fire safety.
- Gain a level 1 qualification from the Kings Trust in resilience.
- Understand:
 - Building resilience, what stronger communities are, becoming part of their community and aspirations for the future.

Main information:

- For this scheme, young people aged **13-17** can be referred using the attached referral form from the **Derbyshire Dales** area.
- The course will run one day a week over the 6-week summer holidays at Ashbourne Fire Station.
- The next BUILD programme will be running from July 30th until September 3rd 2025.

- There will be an **open morning or afternoon the young people must attend** with a guardian/appropriate adult prior to the project commencing. Details of this will be given during follow up conversations.
