Successful prosecution after waste dumped



A Sheffield resident has been successfully prosecuted by North East Derbyshire District Council in relation to a fly tipping incident that occurred on Bramley Moor Lane, Marsh Lane in September 2024.

A significant accumulation of waste was found by a local Parish Councillor who reported it to the District Council.

Evidence was contained on the waste and was investigated North East Derbyshire District Council. The waste was then removed by the Streetscene team at significant cost to the Council.
