# Fit for the future: 10 Year Health Plan for England

The government has just launched its **10-Year Health Plan for England**, outlining the vision for improving NHS health and care services over the next decade.

### The plan focuses on three key shifts:

- · hospital to community
- · analogue to digital
- sickness to prevention

One of the most exciting developments is the creation of a **Neighbourhood Health Service**, with teams working within local communities to help people access and receive care closer to home and free up hospital resources.

#### Some of the key elements are to:

- Establish a neighbourhood health centre in every community, beginning with places where healthy life expectancy is lowest - a 'one stop shop' for patient care and the place from which multidisciplinary teams operate. Neighbourhood health centres will be open at least 12 hours a day and 6 days a week.
- Through the NHS App, allow patients to book appointments, communicate with professionals, receive advice, draft or view their care plan, and self-refer to local tests and services
- Increase the role of community pharmacy in the management of long-term conditions and link them to the single patient record
- Improve access to NHS dentistry, improve children's oral health and increase the number of NHS dentists working in the system
